COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 730, L.D. 2008, Bill, "An Act to Clarify Mileage Reimbursement for Employees of Community Action Agencies"

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph A in the 3rd to 5th lines (page 1, lines 8 to 10 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "except by a community action agency as defined in Title 22, section 5321,"

Further amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph A in the last line (page 1, line 11 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "employees." and inserting in its place the following: 'employees, except that a community action agency as defined in Title 22, section 5321 and the Maine State Housing Authority may reimburse at a greater rate if:

(1) The employee of the agency being reimbursed is not a state employee for the purpose of collective bargaining;

(2) The source of funds to pay for the reimbursement for travel is a nonstate source, including funds from a federal agency that are passed through the State for distribution; and

(3) The rate of reimbursement for travel does not exceed the standard mileage rate for that year, as established by the United States Department of Treasury.'

**SUMMARY**

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This amendment clarifies the intent of the original bill by providing the conditions under which employees of community action agencies and the Maine State Housing Authority may be exempt from the mileage reimbursement rate limit established for state employees.
