Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1541, sub-§13, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 209, is amended to read:

A. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a state agency, as defined in section 8002, subsection 2, may not authorize reimbursement for travel by any person, except by a community action agency as defined in Title 22, section 5321, at a rate greater than the rate established in section 8 for state employees.

SUMMARY

This bill permits a state agency to authorize reimbursement for travel by a community action agency at a rate greater than the rate established for state employees.
