SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 734, L.D. 2012, Bill, "An Act to Provide Funds for the Year 2000 Project"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Provide Funds to Solve Certain Problems Related to State Computers'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in the 8th line (page 1, line 35 in amendment) by striking out the following: "\$3,000,000" and inserting in its place the following: '\$2,000,000'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 by inserting at the end the following:


8 The amendment reduces the amount of the General Fund
