22	Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 (page 1, lines 23 to 44 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 734, L.D. 2012

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2 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, Officer, Budget the State upon 4 recommendation of the Director of the Bureau of Information Services, shall transfer б funds from this contingency fund by financial order to any other department or 8 agency in State Government if it is determined that that transfer would assist 10 an agency in addressing its "Year 2000" information system problem. These transfers 12 are to be considered adjustments to appropriations or allocations. 14 The Director of the Bureau of Information Services shall submit detailed status 16 reports at the close of each fiscal quarter 18 to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over 20 appropriations and financial affairs describing the progress made by each 22 department or agency toward resolution of "Year 2000" information system problems." 24 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the 26 summary the following: 28 **'FISCAL NOTE** 30 1997-98 32 APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS 34 General Fund \$3,000,000 36 38 This bill provides a General Fund appropriation of \$3,000,000 in fiscal year 1997-98 to help solve "Year 2000" 40 problems associated with State Government's various information systems. These funds will not lapse but carry forward until June 42 30, 2001 and may be transferred by financial order to other departments and agencies in State Government. 44 The additional costs associated with the quarterly reporting 46 requirement can be absorbed by the Bureau of Information Services utilizing existing budgeted resources.' 48

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 734, L.D. 2012

SUMMARY

This amendment represents the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs. It increases the General Fund appropriation in fiscal year 1997-98. It also authorizes funds to be transferred to other state agencies if that transfer is determined to be the best solution of a "Year 2000" information system problem. It also amends the carrying provision so that unexpended funds carry only until June 30, 2001. Lastly, it calls for quarterly progress reports by the Director of the Bureau of Information Services to the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs.
