28		G. Signs erected by owners or operators of greenhouses in which crops are grown advertising those crops when the crops
30		are offered for sale on premises where those crops are grown from February 1st to December 25th of each year. Signs may
32		advertise only those crops that are available for immediate purchase. A greenhouse owner or operator may not erect more
34		than 4 signs. A sign may not exceed 8 square feet in size and must be located within 5 miles of the greenhouse.

This bill also extends the same exemption to owners or operators of greenhouses during the period from February 1st to December 25th.
