## COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 739, L.D. 2017

The Finance Authority of Maine's Student Financial 2 Assistance Programs account will require an additional General Fund appropriation of \$25,000 in fiscal year 1998-99 to secure 2 4 positions for Maine students at schools of veterinary medicine. The estimated 2nd-year and 3rd-year costs in fiscal years б 1999-2000 and 2000-01 will be approximately \$50,00 and \$75,000, respectively. Ongoing annual costs, estimated to be \$100,000, 8 will be required beginning in fiscal year 2001-02.' 10 **SUMMARY** 12
