COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 745, L.D. 2023, Bill, "An Act to Restore Services to Maine's Elderly"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part relating to "**Purchased Social Services**" in the 2nd line (page 1, line 20 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "224,605" and inserting in its place the following: '124,605'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in the last line (page 1, line 27 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$383,230" and inserting in its place the following: '\$283,230'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS

General Fund	\$283,230
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This bill includes General Fund appropriations totaling \$283,230 in fiscal year 1998-99 for the Department of Human Services to restore funding to certain programs that provide services to Maine's elderly.'

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SUMMARY

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This amendment reduces the General Fund appropriation to the Purchased Social Services program to accurately reflect the amount required to restore, but not increase, funding for certain services provided by the area agencies on aging.
