Resolve, Requiring the Department of Transportation to Construct a Full-service Rest Area on Interstate 95 30 Miles North of the Medway Rest Area.

Whereas,** Acts and resolves of the 2 Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, there are currently no full-service rest areas on Interstate 95 30 miles north of Medway; and

8 Whereas, for the convenience and safety of travelers on Interstate 95 north of Medway it is essential that a full-service 10 rest area be built and maintained as provided in this resolve; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

18 Sec. 1. Rest area to be constructed. Resolved: That the Department of Transportation shall construct and maintain a 20 full-service rest area on Interstate 95 30 miles north of the rest area in Medway.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve takes effect when approved.

SUMMARY

This resolve directs the Department of Transportation to 30 construct and maintain a full-service rest area on Interstate 95 30 miles north of the rest area in Medway.
