Increasing beano and games of chance license fees will increase dedicated revenue to the Department of Public Safety by \$221,167 in fiscal year 1998-99 and \$241,273 annually beginning in fiscal year 1999-2000. This additional revenue will provide funding to the department for the costs, totaling \$265,559 in fiscal year 1998-99, \$240,249 in fiscal year 1999-2000 and \$241,273 in fiscal year 2000-01, associated with 4 new positions: a Detective; a Clerk Typist III; and 2 Public Safety Inspector I's. These positions are required to provide additional assistance in the enforcement and administration of beano and games of chance activities. There is a sufficient carrying balance in the Beano and Games of Chance account to cover the difference between revenue and allocations in fiscal year 1998-99.

This bill may increase prosecutions for Class D crimes. If a jail sentence is imposed, the additional costs to the counties are estimated to be \$86.45 per day per prisoner. These costs are not reimbursed by the State. The number of prosecutions that may result in a jail sentence and the resulting costs to the county jail system are expected to be insignificant.

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The additional workload, administrative costs and indigent defense costs associated with the minimal number of new criminal cases and civil suits filed in the court system can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department. The

collection of additional fines and filing fees may also increase General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'

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SUMMARY

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This amendment changes the yearly fees for beano, bingo and games of chance licenses from \$432 to \$400 and \$720 to \$700, respectively. This amendment adds a special license fee of \$5 per game. This amendment removes the renting restrictions placed upon licensed organizations as applied to the operation of beano and bingo games. This amendment clarifies that a request for a hearing must be granted to a licensee by the Commissioner of Public Safety in accordance with the Maine Administrative Procedure Act.

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This amendment also adds an allocation and a fiscal note to the bill.

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
