SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1456, L.D. 2047, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the Governor's Advisory Committee on Gambling"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

Sec. 2. 17 MRSA §314-A, sub-§5, as amended by PL 1991, c. 426, §5, is further amended to read:

5. Restrictions. No license may be transferred or assigned. No more than one license may be issued under this section to any federally recognized Indian tribe for any one period. No more than one licensee may operate or conduct a beano game or high-stakes beano game on the same premises on the same date. All games must be conducted at the site of the Scarborough Downs racetrack in the Town of Scarborough or within the Indian Territory of the licensed organization.

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment permits a federally recognized Indian tribe to conduct high-stakes beano or bingo at the site of the Scarborough Downs race-track in the Town of Scarborough.
