18 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "// " to H.P. 1457, L.D. 2048, Bill, "An 20 Act to Provide Property Tax Relief and to Ensure Equitable School Funding"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting 24 the following:

26 'An Act to Ensure Equitable School Funding'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §15605, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1993, c. 410, Pt. KKK, §1, is further amended to read:

Annual certification. Prior to December 15th of each 1. 36 year, the commissioner, with the approval of the state board, shall certify to the Governor and the Bureau of the Budget the 38 funding levels that the commissioner recommends for sections 15604 and 15612. Commencing-with-the-certification-in-December 40 of--1994---and--each--December--thereafter,--the--eemmissioner's recommended-funded-level-may-not-excood-105%-of-the-funding-level 42 in--offoct---for---the---fiscal---year---then---in---progress-----The certification-for-the-fiscal-year-ending-on-June-30,--1994-must-be consistent-with-the-level of funding-provided in the fiscal-year 44 1994-95-biennial-budget.

Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §15653, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 368, Pt. Z, §1 and as affected by §2, is amended to read:

3. Legislature's contribution. The commissioner's appropriation for the Legislature's recommendation for an contribution to the per pupil guarantee for all subsidizable pupils in all school administrative units must be at least the amount of the corresponding appropriation for the prior fiscal year, unless a lesser amount is necessary to ensure compliance with section 15607, subsection 1. The--appropriation-may--net exceed--105%-of--the--corresponding-appropriation-for--the--prior fiseal-year-'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

Eliminating the limitations on the Commissioner of Education's recommended funding level for school subsidy as well as the amount that the Legislature may appropriate for school subsidy may increase requests for General Purpose Aid for Local Schools beginning in fiscal year 1999-2000.'

SUMMARY

26 This amendment replaces the bill and changes the bill's title. The amendment strikes the statutory provisions that limit 28 both the Commissioner of Education's recommended funding level and the Legislature's appropriation for the General Purpose Aid to Local Schools to 105% of the corresponding appropriation for the prior fiscal year. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to 32 the bill.
