Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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_	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §504, sub-§6 is enacted to read:
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	6. Delayed reregistration of certain trucks.
6	Notwithstanding section 405, the Secretary of State may prorate
	the annual registration fee for trucks registered pursuant to
8	this section when:
10	A. The truck was registered for the previous year for a
	gross weight of at least 54,000 pounds;

	B. The registrant returns the registration plate and
14	registration certificate within 30 days after expiration; and
16	C. The registrant completes a statement of nonuse indicating an intention not to operate the truck on a public
18	highway for at least 3 months.
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20	The registrant may renew the truck's registration by paying a
	prorated registration fee determined by dividing the annual fee
22	by 12 and multiplying by the number of months remaining in the
	truck registration year. The minimum registration fee must be
24	at least 50% of the annual registration fee.
26	Nothing in this section may be construed to alter or advance a
20	registration expiration date or to affect municipal excise tax.
