HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1468, L.D. 2059, Bill, "An Act to Repeal Certain Archaic and Unenforced Laws"

Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting clause and before section 1 the following:

'Sec. 1. 10 MRSA §1661-B, as enacted by PL 1989, c. 83, §2, is repealed.'

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

Current law requires gas stations to post the price of gas on each pump on a sign at least 64 square inches in size. This amendment repeals this requirement entirely.
