3 December 31, 2001, the Department of Transportation shall
4 reconstruct or repair portions of Route 11 between the Town of
5 Sherman and the Town of Ashland in such a fashion as to permit
6 commercial and passenger vehicles to utilize Route 11 during all
7 days of the year; and be it further

8 **Sec. 2. Reconstruction and repair, Route 1. Resolved:** That, by
9 December 31, 2001, the Department of Transportation shall
10 reconstruct, repair, widen or add passing lanes to portions of
11 Route 1 in Aroostook County to ensure safe passage throughout the
12 county and reduce accidents.
