

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 768, L.D. 2069, Bill, "An Act to Improve Public Health Protection Against Rabies Infection"

Amend the amendment in section 11 in the first paragraph in the 5th line (page 3, line 41 in amendment) by striking out the following: "may must" and inserting in its place the following: 'may'

SUMMARY

Committee Amendment "A" requires the removal of an undomesticated animal or wolf hybrid if that animal is suspected of having rabies and that animal exposes a person or domestic animal to rabies. This amendment doesn't require such a removal, but instead authorizes such a removal.
