HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1476, L.D. 2075, "Resolve, to Allow David Prentiss to Sue the State of Maine"

Amend the resolve by striking out all of the emergency preamble.

Further amend the resolve in section 1 in the last paragraph in the 4th line (page 1, line 42 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$250,000" and inserting in its place the following: '\$70,000'

Further amend the resolve by striking out all of the emergency clause.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment decreases the potential General Fund cost of the bill by \$180,000 by reducing the cap of the award from \$250,000 to \$70,000.

SUMMARY

This amendment limits the amount of money that David Prentiss can receive from the State to \$70,000 and also removes the emergency preamble and emergency clause.
