Transfer of funds. Resolved: That, notwithstanding the 34 Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1585, the Department of Administrative and Financial Services shall transfer \$1,000 from 36 the Bureau of Revenue Services to the Legislature toward the cost of the per diem and expenses of legislative members; and be it 38 further Sec. 9. Budget authorization. Resolved: 40 That the expenses of members who are not state or federal employees and public 42 meetings and miscellaneous costs of the task force must be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Department of 44 Economic and Community Development; and be it further 46 Sec. 10. Allocation. Resolved: That the following funds are allocated from Other Special Revenue to carry out the purposes of 48 this resolve.

28 This amendment decreases the General Fund cost of the bill by \$11,860 in fiscal year 1998-99 by eliminating the General Fund 30 appropriation to the Legislature.

32 The amendment includes an Other Special Revenue funds allocation to the Legislature in 1998-99 of \$1,000 from funds 34 transferred by the Bureau of Revenue Services to be used for the per diem and expenses of legislative members of the task force.

The Department of Economic and Community Development will be 38 required to absorb any additional costs, estimated to be \$5,500, associated with the task force.

SUMMARY

44 This amendment clarifies that the Task Force to Increase Primary and Secondary Forest Product Manufacturing will hold 4 46 public meetings and that the meetings are to be held in certain specified counties. It also eliminates the General Fund

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SENATE AMENDMENT

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Appropriation for the costs of the task force. It instead authorizes a transfer from the Bureau of Revenue Services to fund \$1,000 of the costs for legislative members and requires the Department of Economic and Community Development to absorb other task force expenses.
