An Act to Allow Recognition of Private Schools with Outstanding Residential Counseling Programs.

Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §3003 is enacted to read:

<u>§3003. Recognition of outstanding counseling program</u>

The Department of Human Services, as provided in Title 22, 8 section 4-A, may issue a certificate recognizing an approved private school for its outstanding residential counseling program 10 for troubled adolescents.

Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §4-A is enacted to read:

#### 14 <u>§4-A. Recognition of outstanding counseling program</u>

16 The department may issue a certificate recognizing a private school approved under Title 20-A, chapter 117 for its outstanding 18 residential counseling program for troubled adolescents. This section authorizes the department to use its discretion in 20 determining effective programs, but does not authorize the department to regulate those programs.

### **SUMMARY**

This bill authorizes the Department of Human Services to 28 issue a certificate recognizing private schools that provide outstanding residential counseling programs for troubled 30 adolescents.
