HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1488, L.D. 2087, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Tax-exempt Status of the Maine School of Science and Mathematics"

Amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency preamble and emergency clause.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment will reduce the amount of the reductions of General Fund revenue and dedicated revenue to the Local Government Fund by an insignificant amount in fiscal year 1998-99.

This amendment removes the emergency preamble and emergency clause from the bill.
