28	'5. Deposit of fees. All fees collected must be deposited in a dedicated account within the Office of Chief Medical Examiner. At the end of each fiscal year, the State Controller
30	shall transfer all unencumbered balances in excess of \$500 to the General Fund as undedicated revenue.'
