HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1497, L.D. 2096, Bill, "An Act to Give Collective Bargaining Rights to Legislative Employees"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 10 the following:

'Sec. 11. 26 MRSA §979-R is enacted to read:


§979-R. Union dues checkoff

Each legislative employee who wants that legislative employee's union dues used for political activities must affirmatively indicate that preference at the time of hiring and annually each year thereafter.'

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment requires that unionized legislative employees indicate whether they do or do not want their dues used for political campaign activities at the time of hiring and annually each year thereafter.
