HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 1497, L.D. 2096, Bill, "An Act to Give Collective Bargaining Rights to Legislative Employees"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 12 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 12. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 1999.'

This amendment eliminates the General Fund cost of the bill in fiscal year 1998-99 by \$113,230 by establishing the effective date for collective bargaining rights for legislative employees at July 1, 1999. Fiscal year 1999-2000 General Fund appropriation requirements are expected to be approximately \$135,400.

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
SUMMARY
