Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §566 is enacted to read:

§566. Local development commission may assess user fee

A local development commission may assess a user fee against a property owner for the cost of municipal services provided to that owner's property. This fee has the same priority as a real estate tax lien pursuant to section 552 and may be enforced in the same manner as a real estate tax lien pursuant to section 552 and sections 941 to 948.
