COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 776, L.D. 2103, Bill, "An Act to Improve the Efficiency of the Maine Public Drinking Water Control Program"

Amend the bill in the 5th paragraph after the title in the next to the last line (page 1, line 27 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Drinking Water State" and inserting in its place the following: 'Safe Drinking Water'

Further amend the bill in the 6th paragraph after the title in the 2nd line (page 1, line 31 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Drinking Water State" and inserting in its place the following: 'Safe Drinking Water'

Further amend the bill in Part A by striking out all of section 6 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. A-6. Funding for audit. The Maine Public Drinking Water Commission shall provide funding for the audit under this section from federal funds available for drinking water programs under the jurisdiction of the Department of Human Services. The commission is authorized to determine the funding level of the audit, but may not spend more than \$25,000.

Sec. A-7. Allocation. The following funds are allocated from Other Special Revenue to carry out the purposes of this Act.

32 This amendment is the majority report of the Joint Standing  
34 Committee on Health and Human Services. It replaces the bill.  
36 It changes the source of funding for the audit of the Maine  
Public Drinking Water Control Program from the Public Drinking  
38 Water Fund to federal funds held by the Department of Human  
Services. It also adds an appropriation section and a fiscal  
note to the bill.
