COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " β " to S.P. 776, L.D. 2103

'Sec. 1. Required strategic plan. Resolved: That the Maine
Public Drinking Water Commission and the Department of Human Services shall jointly prepare a strategic plan for the Maine
Public Drinking Water Control Program and a report to the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services by September 15, 1998.

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1. Strategic plan. The strategic plan must address the following issues:

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A. The organizational structure of the Maine Public Drinking Water Control Program;

14 B. The current management information system;

16 C. A 3-year plan for funding the program adequately;

18 D. Measurable goals and objectives for the program, presented with benchmarks and measurements standards for 20 each year; and

E. A process for comparing each year's progress to that year's goals and objectives and revising the strategic plan
for the following years.

2. Report. The report to the committee must contain the strategic plan and information on the progress of the Maine
 28 Public Drinking Water Control Program in meeting the goals and objectives of the strategic plan. The report must also address
 30 staffing levels and contracted employment within the Maine Public Drinking Water Control Program and the adequacy of funding
 32 appropriated and allocated for expenditure by the program, the Maine Public Drinking Water Commission or the Department of Human
 34 Services to support the program.'

36 Further amend the bill in the emergency clause in the 2nd line (page 3, line 38 in L.D.) by striking out the following: 38 "Act" and inserting in its place the following: 'resolve'

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " β " to S.P. 776, L.D. 2103

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SUMMARY

This amendment is the minority report of the Joint Standing 6 Committee on Health and Human Services. It replaces the substance of the bill. It corrects the name of the fund in the 8 emergency preamble. It provides for a strategic plan and a report jointly prepared by the Department of Human Services and 10 the Maine Public Drinking Water Commission. The report is due September 15, 1998. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the 12 bill.
