26	appropriation of \$1,300 in fiscal year 1998-99 and every fourt odd-numbered fiscal year thereafter for the per diem and expense
28	of members of the Legislative Compensation Commission. Beginning in fiscal year 1999-2000 and every fourth even-numbered fisca
30	year thereafter, the cost will be approximately \$6,125 to provide funding for three public hearings and for printing costs of the required report. The additional costs associated with providing
32	staffing assistance to the commission can be absorbed by the
34	Legislature during any interim between sessions utilizing existing budgeted resources. If the commission requests staffing assistance during a legislative session, the Legislature may
36	require additional General Fund appropriations for contracte staff services.

40	The bill requires that a joint order be presented to approve the compensation recommendations of the commission. The future costs of any salary increases that will be included in a join

- It requires the Legislative Compensation Commission to
   hold 3 public hearings throughout the State and 4 working meetings based on a specific time line.
- 2. It changes the date the commission reports to January 5 15, 2000.
- 8 3. It removes the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over state and local government 10 matters from the process. The commission shall hold public hearings and work meetings then issue its report to the 12 Legislative Council, which shall introduce the recommendations in a joint order.
- 4. It specifies what the commission must consider when determining pay and benefits for work in and out of session.
