SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 781, L.D. 2108, Bill, "An Act to Have a Referendum on Whether or Not an Independent Public Commission Should be Established to Set Legislative Pay"

Amend the bill in section 3 in that part designated "S2-C." in subsection 4 in paragraph B in the 5th line (page 2, line 12 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "mileage" the following: ', health care and other benefits'

Further amend the bill in section 3 in that part designated "S2-C." in subsection 4 in paragraph B in the 6th line (page 2, line 13 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "allowances" the following: ', including federal tax benefits for those Legislators living more than 50 miles from Augusta'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the Legislative Compensation Commission must address health care and other benefits and federal tax benefits in its recommendations.
