COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 783, L.D. 2110, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Laws Regarding the Consensus Revenue Forecasting 20 Process"

Amend the bill in section 4 in that part designated "**§1710-E.**" in the 11th to 14th lines (page 2, lines 46 to 49 in 24 L.D.) by striking out the following: ", an economist from the Office of Fiscal and Program Revenue and the analyst who provides 26 staffing assistance to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over taxation matters" 28 and inserting in its place the following: 'and an analyst from the 30 Office of Fiscal and Program Review designated by the director of that office'

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Further amend the bill in section 4 in that part designated "\$1710-E." in the 14th line (page 2, line 49 in L.D.) by striking 34 out the following: " $\underline{7}$ " and inserting in its place the following: '6' 36

Further amend the bill in section 5 by striking out all of 38 that part designated "\$1710-G." (page 3, lines 7 to 26 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following" 40

42 '§1710-G. Use of revenue forecasts

44 The State Budget Officer shall eensider use the revenue projections recommended by the committee in setting revenue estimates in accordance with section 1665, subsection 3. 46 The State Budget Officer shall use the revenue projections of the committee in preparing General Fund and Highway Fund revenue and 48 expenditure forecasts in accordance with section 1664 and section 50 1665, subsection 7. If new information becomes available and the State Budget Officer adjusts wishes to recommend an adjustment to

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the revenue projections already recommended by the committee in 2 setting--revenue--estimates--in--accordance--with--section--1665, subsection--3,--the--State-Budget--Officer--shall--submit--to--the 4 Governor, --- the --- Legislative -- Council --- and -- the --- joint --- standing eemmittee---of----the---Legislature---having---jurisdiction---over 6 appropriations - and - financial - affairs - a - report - that - presents - the analyses, -- findings-- and -- recommendations-- by -- revenue -- line -- and 8 explains - the -variances - from -the -revenue - projections - recommended by--the--committee, the State Budget Officer shall convene a 10 meeting of the committee as soon as practicable so that the committee may review any new data and make any additional 12 recommendations it feels necessary.'

14 Further amend the bill by inserting after section 5 the following:

'Sec. 6. 5 MRSA §1710-H, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 368, Pt. 18 J, §1, is amended to read:

20 §1710-H. Meetings

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22 The committee shall meet at least 4 times a year. Additional meetings may be called by a majority vote of the 24 committee or by the State Budget Officer as specified in section 1710-G.'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 6.

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the 30 summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The additional administrative costs associated with an 36 increase in the legislative membership of the Revenue Forecasting Committee can be absorbed by the Legislature utilizing existing 38 budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

This is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs. It amends the bill to add only one new member from nonpartisan legislative staff. It also changes the current process for setting final revenue estimates in that the State Budget Officer's authority to adjust the revenue projections recommended by the Revenue Forecasting

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Committee is removed. In its place, the State Budget Officer is authorized to convene a meeting of the committee should new data become available. The amendment also removes the appropriation section and adds a fiscal note.

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
