HOUSE AMENDMENT """ to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 784, L.D. 2111, Bill, "An Act to Reauthorize the Toxics and Hazardous Waste Reduction Laws"

Amend the amendment in section 5 in subsection 17 by 20 inserting at the end the following: '<u>"Toxics releaser" does not</u> <u>include a person engaged in recycling as that term is defined in</u> 22 <u>section 1303-C, subsection 22.</u>'

Further amend the amendment in section 6 in subsection 19 by inserting at the end the following: <u>"Toxics user" does not</u> include a person engaged in recycling as that term is defined in section 1303-C, subsection 22.

FISCAL NOTE

Exempting recyclers from the toxics use reduction goals may 32 reduce by minor amounts dedicated revenues collected for the Hazardous Waste Fund within the Department of Environmental 34 Protection.

SUMMARY

38 This amendment exempts from the toxics use reduction goals, as amended by the bill and Committee Amendment "A," those persons 40 who collect, separate, recover and sell or reuse materials that would otherwise be disposed of or processed as waste, or who 42 mechanically separate and treat waste, other than through combustion, or who create and recover reusable materials other 44 than as a fuel for the generation of electricity.
