HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 784, L.D. 2111, Bill, "An Act to Reauthorize the Toxics and Hazardous Waste Reduction Laws"


Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 4 and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 4. 38 MRSA §2301, sub-§16, as amended by PL 1991, c. 520, §9, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

16. Toxic substance or toxics. "Toxic substance" or "toxics" means any substance in a gaseous, liquid or solid state that is listed pursuant to the SARA, Title III, Section 313 and listed in 40 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 372.65; that is listed in 40 Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 423, Appendix A and discharged to waters of the State in amounts of 2,000 pounds or more in a calendar year; or that is listed in rules pertaining to emission statements that have been adopted by the board as of the effective date of this subsection pursuant to section 585-C and is emitted to the ambient air in corresponding reportable quantity.'

SUMMARY

This amendment links the applicability of the provisions of the bill to existing federal regulations and state rules.
