HOUSE AMENDMENT "E" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 784, L.D. 2111, Bill, "An Act to Reauthorize the Toxics and Hazardous Waste Reduction Laws"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 4 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 4. 38 MRSA §2301, sub-§16, as amended by PL 1991, c. 520, §9, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

16. Toxic substance or toxics. "Toxic substance" or "toxics" means any substance in a gaseous, liquid or solid state:

A. Listed in 40 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 372.65 and released in the corresponding reportable quantity;

B. Listed in 40 Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 423, Appendix A and discharged to waters of the State in amounts of 2,000 pounds or more in a calendar year;  
or

C. Listed in rules adopted by the board pursuant to section 585-C and emitted to the ambient air in the corresponding reportable quantity and does not include a release that is incidental to a facility's administrative functions or meets the exemption provisions established in 40 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 372.38.'

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
