30	SUMMARY
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34	This amendment restores a reference to the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986 that was stricken in the committee amendment. The amendment also exempts from the
36	hazardous waste requirements one-time cleanups of broken motor vehicle batteries and transformers if the cleanup is approved for
38	an exemption by the Commissioner of Environmental Protection.
