	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §603 is enacted to read:
4	\$603. Limits on mandatory overtime

8	1. Definitions. As used in this section, unless the context otherwise indicates, the following terms have the following meanings.

12	A. "Employee" does not include a person who is a seasonal employee.
14	B. "Overtime" means the hours worked in excess of 8 hours in a day or the hours worked in excess of 40 hours in a
16	calendar week.
18	2. Limits on overtime. An employer may not require an
20	employee to work overtime in violation of the following limitations:
22	A. An employer may not require an employee to work more than 32 overtime hours in any one calendar week; and

26	B. An employer may not require an employee to work overtime on more than 6 days in a calendar week.

30	SUMMARY
32	This bill prohibits an employer from requiring an employee, except a seasonal employee, to work more than 32 overtime hours in any one calendar week and from requiring an employee to work
34	overtime on more than 6 days in a calendar week.
