Support for Persons in Retraining and Employment (ASPIRE) program. The ASPIRE funding is available since budgeted allocations exceed the current projections of the cost of that program.

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## SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill. It adds an emergency preamble and an emergency clause. It requires an increase in benefits under the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families program (TANF) by 5% of the benefit amount in effect on January 1, 1998, while disallowing the increase for households receiving the earned income disregard. The increase will not affect households receiving the special housing allowance continuously from June 1, 1998. Eligibility will be determined for new applicants for TANF using the gross income pretest in effect on January 1, 1998. The amendment also adds an appropriation, an

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
