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SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 792, L.D. 2119, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Responsibilities of the Advisory Commission on Radioactive Waste during the Decommissioning of Maine Yankee"

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Amend the amendment in subsection 2 by striking out all of paragraph H and inserting in its place the following:

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'H. Four members of the general public with a knowledge of and interest in the management of radioactive materials and radioactive waste, 2 of whom are appointed by the Governor, one of whom is appointed by the President of the Senate and one of whom is appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives. Of these 4 members, one must be a resident of the local community in which the nuclear power plant is located and one must represent a local advisory group on nuclear power plants; and'

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SUMMARY

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
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This amendment clarifies that of the 4 public members, one must reside in the community in which the nuclear power plant is located and one must represent a local advisory group on nuclear power plants.
