Sec. 1. Entrance fee. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Transportation shall set the fee to be charged a commercial vehicle that enters Maine from New Brunswick, Canada to be the same as the fee that is charged a commercial vehicle that enters New Brunswick, Canada from Maine.

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SUMMARY

The purpose of this resolve is to authorize the Commissioner of Transportation to set the entrance fee for a commercial vehicle to Maine from New Brunswick, Canada at the same level as the fee is from Maine to New Brunswick.
