Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated " <u>§964-A.</u> " in the first paragraph in the next to last line (page 1, line 32 in amendment) by inserting after the following: " <u>contract</u> " the following: ' <u>pertaining to disciplinary action</u> '
Further amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated " §979-R. " in the first paragraph in the next to last line (page 1, line 41 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "contract" the following: ' <u>pertaining to</u> <u>disciplinary action</u> '
Further amend the amendment in section 3 in that part designated " §1284-A. " in the first paragraph in the next to last line (page 1, line 50 in amendment) by inserting after the following: " <u>contract</u> " the following: ' <u>pertaining to</u> <u>disciplinary action</u> '
SUMMARY
