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SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1503, L.D. 2125, Bill, "An Act to Improve Public Sector Labor Relations"

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Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "~~S964-A.~~" in the first paragraph in the next to last line (page 1, line 32 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "contract" the following: 'pertaining to disciplinary action'

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Further amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "~~S979-R.~~" in the first paragraph in the next to last line (page 1, line 41 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "contract" the following: 'pertaining to disciplinary action'

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Further amend the amendment in section 3 in that part designated "~~S1284-A.~~" in the first paragraph in the next to last line (page 1, line 50 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "contract" the following: 'pertaining to disciplinary action'

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SUMMARY

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This amendment specifies that the grievance arbitration provisions of expired contracts that pertain to disciplinary action remain in effect until the parties execute a new contract.


