Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

'Amend the bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:

24

'Mandate preamble. This measure requires one or more local units of government to expand or modify activities so as to necessitate additional expenditures from local revenues but does not provide funding for at least 90% of those expenditures. Pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 21, two thirds of all of the members elected to each House have determined it necessary to enact this measure.'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill requires municipal public employers to continue to honor certain grievance arbitration provisions of expired collective bargaining agreements pending the approval of a new agreement. The additional costs of this state mandate can not be determined at this time. Pursuant to the Mandate Preamble, the two-thirds vote of all members elected to each House exempts the
