42	(2) If the ordinance sets a fee of more than \$200 for a resident license, the fee for a nonresident license may not exceed 1 1/2 times the resident fee.'

46	SUMMARY
48	The amendment provides that if a shellfish conservation ordinance charges \$200 or less for a resident license, the fee
50	for a nonresident license may not exceed twice the resident fee. It also provides that if the ordinance charges more than \$200 for
