	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6671, sub-§3-A, ¶B, as amended by PL 1997, c.
4	247, §1, is further amended to read:
6	B. A shellfish conservation ordinance may fix license fees. The fee for a nonresident license may not exceed
8	twice 1 1/2 times the resident fee.
10	Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act takes effect January 1, 1999.

14	SUMMARY  This bill changes the maximum fee that a municipality can
16	charge a nonresident for a shellfish license from twice the resident fee to 1 1/2 times the resident fee.
