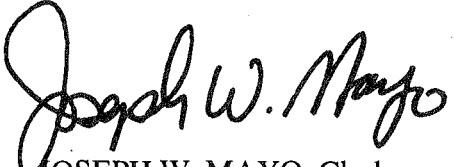

Sec. 1. Lease with South Portland Housing Authority. Resolved:

2 That the Legislature does hereby authorize the South Portland
Housing Authority, its designee or its authorized entity and the
4 Maine Technical College System to enter into a 40-year land lease
to enable the South Portland Housing Authority, its designee or
6 its authorized entity to construct low-income and
moderate-income, elder-care housing on property currently owned
8 by the Maine Technical College System. The initial term of that
lease may not exceed 40 years.

12 **SUMMARY**

14 This resolve authorizes the Maine Technical College System
and the South Portland Housing Authority, its designee or its
16 authorized entity to enter into a 40-year lease whereby the South
Portland Housing Authority will lease from the Maine Technical
18 College System approximately 3.5 acres of property adjacent to
the Southern Maine Technical College campus for purposes of
20 constructing and providing low-income and moderate-income,
elder-care housing for the citizens of Maine.
