HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1510, L.D. 2132, Bill, "An Act to Repeal the Sunsets on Certain Child Support Enforcement Remedies"

Amend the amendment by inserting after section 6 the following:


'Sec. 7. 19-A MRSA §2662, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 694, Pt. B, §2 and affected by Pt. E, §2, is amended to read:

2. Failure to send income withheld. A payor who knowingly fails to send income withheld to the department within 7 business days of its withholding commits a civil violation for which a forfeiture not to exceed \$100 for each failure to timely send income withheld from an obligor may be adjudged.'

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment corrects an oversight in the committee amendment by specifying that a payor who withholds income but fails to send it to the Department of Human Services within 7 business days of the withholding is subject to a civil forfeiture.
