30	This bill repeals the sunset provisions on orders to seize
32	and sell and orders to appear and disclose. This bill also repeals the sunset provisions on authorizing a nonattorney to
34	represent the Department of Human Services in a child support enforcement matter requesting an order to seek employment; and on
36	enforcing or collecting a lien through an order to seize and sell. The repeal of these sunset provisions will permit
38	continuance and enhancement of child support revenue producing

statutes.
