24	clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:
26	Sec.1. 22 MRSA §1064 is enacted to read:
28	§1064. Immunization information system
30	The department shall establish an immunization information system and require all immunization providers who participate in
32	the department's immunization distribution system to submit to
34	the department a record of each immunization administered.
26	The department shall adopt rules to implement this section.
36	The rules must include, but are not limited to, provisions for: permitting a person or the parent or guardian of that person to
38	choose not to be included in the system; the format for reporting
40	information; the confidentiality of information in the system; penalties for unauthorized disclosure of information; immunity
	for good-faith disclosure of information; data transmission; and

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "M" to H.P. 1511, L.D. 2133

department must pursue federal funding to support the cost of the information system. Any state match required to secure federal 4 funding must be made available from existing budget resources.' 6 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the 8 summary the following: **'FISCAL NOTE** 10 12 This bill authorizes the Department of Human Services to establish an immunization information system. The department has 14 already begun to develop this system. This bill requires the department to seek federal funds for the cost of this system and to absorb any state match required to secure those federal funds 16 within existing budgeted resources.' 18 20 SUMMARY 22 This amendment directs the Department of Human Services to establish an immunization information system. It allows persons to choose not to be included in the system. 24 It requires rulemaking regarding the opt-out process, confidentiality, 26 penalties for unauthorized disclosure, immunity for good-faith disclosure, data transmission and department access to 28 information on those persons who have chosen not to be included in the system to control an outbreak of a disease preventable by 30

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immunization. It delays implementation of the immunization information system until the receipt of federal funds. It also 32 adds a fiscal note to the bill.
