SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1523, L.D. 2145, Bill, "An Act Concerning the Taking of Marine Resources by Members of the Passamaquoddy Tribe"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "~~§6302-A.~~" in subsection 2 by striking out all of paragraph A (page 2, lines 29 to 35 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'A. Any marine organism, except lobster, for sustenance use if the tribal member holds a valid sustenance fishing license issued by the tribe. A sustenance fishing license holder who fishes for sea urchins may not harvest sea urchins out of season;'


