COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1529, L.D. 2151, Bill, "An Act to Regulate the Functioning of End-stage Renal Disease Facilities"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§2041." in subsection 1 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 16 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "ERSD" and inserting in its place the following: 'ESRD'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

REVENUES

General Fund \$5,000

The additional costs associated with licensing End-stage Renal Disease facilities can be absorbed by the Department of Human Services utilizing existing budgeted resources. The licensing fee to be established for these facilities is expected to increase undedicated General Fund revenue by \$5,000 annually beginning in fiscal year 1998-99.
