14	Notwithstanding section 304-A, subsection 6-A, paragraph B, a rural hospital with fewer than 100 licensed acute care beds may change the existing bed complement of the hospital to provide a
16	particular level of care without receiving a certificate of need
18	under this chapter.
20	SUMMARY
22	Under current law, a hospital must obtain a certificate of need before it increases the number of beds licensed or certified
24	by the Department of Human Services to provide a particular level of care by more than 10% or more than 5 beds. This bill exempts
26	rural small hospitals from that requirement.
