COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 796, L.D. 2154, Bill, "An Act to Improve State House Utilization"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 12 in the first paragraph in the last 3 lines (page 1, lines 14 to 16 in L.D.) by striking out all of the last sentence and inserting in its place the following: ~~'This space shall be assigned for use by the Legislature as offices for chairs of joint standing committees and legislative staff and for public hearing rooms~~ The Legislative Council shall ensure that the Governor and the Governor's staff occupy sufficient and appropriate office space within the State House.'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment adds language requiring the Legislative Council to ensure that the Governor and the Governor's staff have sufficient and appropriate office space in the State House. It also strikes language in current law specifying the uses the Legislative Council may make of the State House space.
