SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1535, L.D. 2162, "Resolve, to Authorize the Maine State Museum to Purchase Historic Maine Artifacts"

Amend the resolve by striking out all of the emergency preamble.

Further amend the resolve in section 1 in the 4th line (page 1, line 21 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "1997-98" and inserting in its place the following: '1998-99'

Further amend the resolve in the section 1 in the blocked paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 31 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "artifacts" the following: 'or to reimburse another organization for the purchase of historic artifacts'

Further amend the resolve by striking out all of the emergency clause.

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:
